Presentation College Atherry Study Sessions 2019-2020

There are both two hour & three hour study options available. Study runs from Monday to Thursday 4.15pm to 6.15pm/7.15pm and on Fridays from 2pm to 4/5pm. Places are limited and operate on a 'first come, first served' basis only

Terms: **Term 1** runs from **Sept 2nd to January 10th.**
Term 2 runs from **January 13th to May 27th.**

Fees:
2 hour study is €240 per term
3 hour study is €360 per term.

A **15% discount** applies if more than one family member is taking part in study. The discount also applies to any student who pays for the full year in advance.

Students are allocated their seat only after payment has been made. Students must commit to partaking in study each evening. In the event that a student cannot attend on any given evening, this must be explained beforehand on the study contract (see below). Discounts or refunds are not available in the event that a student cannot fully participate. This is due to difficulty in allocating the students' seat to another participant on the particular day(s) that they are absent.

Students and parents must sign a study contract outlining the terms and conditions, and return this form to the study co-ordinator, along with payment. Forms are available from the study coordinator or on the ledge outside the main office window.

For cash or cheque payments, please ensure that all fees are in an enclosed envelope with the students' details written on the front. **Please ensure that all envelopes are given to the study co-ordinator only.** Payments without an envelope and the students' details will not be accepted. Please make all cheques payable to Presentation College Atherry.

Friday Study:

Evening study is also available for students who wish to partake on Fridays only. Two hour study is €50 per term. Three hour study is €75 per term.

Saturday Study:

Saturday morning study is available to all. Study runs from 9am to 1pm (subject to change closer to exam time). The cost per session is €5 and is payable on the day. No prior notice is required from students. Students do not need to commit to attending on a weekly basis. Students must bring a note which excuses them from study if they need to leave before the end of the session.
